Jesus was made sin so that in him we might be made the righteousness of God. - 2 Cor. 5:21

The only thing we can bring to Christ before we receive him as Savior and King is our filthy rags, but when we accept his blood covenant inheritance based on his death and resurrection, we receive his robe of righteousness. We are no longer a helpless beggar, but a child of the King! We have his divine favor and confidence to walk in boldness and authority, not only in to God's presence but also against the forces of darkness. - Revelation 12:11 Blood covenant, Believers Confession and Commitment
