SHOOT THE GUN December 2014 to our Prayer Team

Many times about 80% of what we learn in school is not very useful. It can be true for Bible Schools and Seminaries too. Our discipleship course aim is to cover the 20% useful stuff. That truth alone could have saved me from so many mistakes in my earlier walk. The subject of spiritual warfare was non-existent in most churches until Frank Peretti wrote his book called This Present Darkness over 25 years ago.

When I was in my late 20's I began to have a voracious or ravenous appetite for God's Word. We had no Internet resources to access. However, I found a few free different lending libraries across the country that had thousands of messages. I borrowed 10-12 per month and took lots of notes. It took 2-3 hours to take notes on an hour message. I was hungry. Malcolm Smith had a 12 tape series on The Lord's Prayer. The last tape was just on the word - Amen! He traced its roots back to a passage in the O.T. where it meant, God Faithful King.

My point in all of this. We can learn and grow as much as we really want to. God gave me an extra hunger for the Word because He knew I was going to be a teacher of His Word. Your calling may be different. I see that same hunger in Ryan because he is also a teacher in the making. All of you however, will be teaching others in some way and in fact are doing so already in some form. I have several books to be written. Out of those will come shorter versions to be placed in course form which are more easily digested by the ordinary believer. One step at a time and it will be just fine for all of you. I will be praying Philippians 1:9-10 over each of you the next several weeks. Perhaps you will join me :) I care about all of you. You are in my heart. I can see God has good things planned for each one of you. Do you believe it? God does. I know you pray for me. I feel empowered these days in many ways. God's creativity is flowing.
