Much of the teaching by many media preachers on the subject of money and even many other topics tends to be man centered not God centered. All of us have looked to alternate sources for our needs to be met rather than look to God. God wants us to remember that He is the source of every good and perfect gift. - James 1:17. He can be trusted to meet all of our needs. Although He uses others to be channels of blessing to us at times, we must not look to others to meet our needs but look only to God from whom all blessings flow.

God sought to teach His people this lesson after He delivered them out of slavery in Egypt, brought them through the Red Sea and then led them into the desert. They had to trust God fully for their daily needs of food, water, clothing and good health. As they prepared to enter the promised land, God spoke:

**Remember how the the Lord your God led you all the way in the desert these forty years, to humble you and to test you in order to know what was in your heart, whether or not you would keep His commands. He humbled you, causing you to hunger and then feeding you with manna, which neither you nor your fathers had known, to teach you that man does not live on bread alone but on every word that comes from the mouth of God. Your clothes did not wear out and your feet did not swell during these forty years. - Deuteronomy 8:2-4 NIV**

God then told them about the promised land with abundant water, food and other resources. He then warned them that when they became prosperous, not to become proud in heart and forget Him, nor how He saved them out of Egypt and brought them safely through the vast desert. - Deut.8:10-16.

**You may say to yourself, 'My power and the strength of my hands have produced this wealth for me'. But remember the Lord your God, for it is He who gives you the ability to produce wealth, and so confirms His covenant, which He swore to your forefathers, as it is today. If you ever forget the Lord your God and follow other gods and worship and bow down to them, I testify against you today that you will surely be destroyed. - Deuteronomy 8:17-19 NIV**
