There is much **spiritual gold** ahead of you, just waiting to be found!

It is the glory of God to conceal a matter, But the glory of kings is to search out a matter. - Proverbs 25:2 NKJV

If you call out for insight and cry aloud for understanding, and you look for it as for silver and search for it as for hidden treasure, then you will understand the fear of the Lord and find the knowledge of God. For the Lord gives wisdom, and from his mouth come knowledge and understanding. He holds victory in store for the upright, he is a shield to those whose walk is blameless. - Proverbs 2:3-7 NIV

The kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field. When a man found it, he hid it again, and then in his joy went and sold all that he had and bought that field. Invisible & Supernatural

Luke 17:20-21 like thewind 2 Kings 6:8-18 chariots of fire Matthew 16:28-17:1-8 transfiguration Hebrews 11:3 creation formed from the invisible (God's Words) (This verse does not teach that God created the world by faith and that He is a faith God as taught by many. God does not need faith, for He sees all things.) We are the ones who need to understand by faith.

Powerful Kingdom of power, not just words 1 Corinthians 2:4-5, 1 Corinthians 4:20, 1 Thessalonians 1:5 Matthew 4:23; 11:12; 13:3, 11-33 The kingdom influence never stops growing. A little seed becomes **BIG**. Jesus started with only 12 disciples. At Pentecost they went from 120 to 3000. One report says they grew to 50,000 in 6 months. Over the next 200 years they grew to over 6 million.

Yeast expands and effects its environment. The Roman Empire felt the impact of the Christians.

- How should this effect our faith level? Our perseverance & commitment?
- Who is in your circle of influence?

PURIFYING Matthew 5: 13-16

Early on Jesus puts VISION into his disciples by calling them SALT..... it purifies, preserves, brings flavor and zest.....a little goes a long way. Where is salt most useful? - Luke 14:34-35

God's Kingdom is Future

Some aspects of God's kingdom will only be revealed and enjoyed until the second coming of Jesus Christ, when he restores the kingdom over all the earth. This is when the fullness of his glory will cover the whole earth as the waters cover the sea. - Habakkuk 2:14. God wants his people to be salt and light in all areas of society and exercise his authority and influence now, but there will be no theocracy until Jesus returns.

He (Jesus) must remain in heaven until the time comes for God to restore everything, as he promised long ago through his holy prophets. - Acts 3:21

Then the end will come, when (Jesus) hands over the kingdom to God the Father after he has destroyed all dominion, authority and power. For he must reign until he has put all enemies under his feet. - 1 Corinthians 15:24-25

His Eternal Plan Is Fulfilled:

a. Destroy his enemies - Matthew 13:36-43

- 1 Corinth. 15:23-25
- 1 John 3:8

b. Liberate mankind from their grasp - Luke 4:14-21, Isaiah 61:1-3
 Jesus' kingdom manifesto brings deliverance, liberation and healing in all areas of life...spiritual, economic, physical, emotional He has given us a foretaste while he walked this earth and now through his church, but it will be in totality when he returns to earth.

c. Establish his reign upon earth through the Son Jesus Christ

Matthew 25:31-41 How can we prepare for the kingdom? Who are the king's brothers?

Luke 19:11-27 What happens to those who reject the king?

Acts 1:6-8 Where will the kingdom go before it visibly returns to Israel?

2 Peter 1:3-11 What assures us of a rich welcome in the kingdom?

GOD'S KINGDOM IS ETERNAL

Then the sovereignty, the dominion and the greatness of all kingdoms under the whole heaven will be given to the people of the saints of the Highest One; His kingdom will be an everlasting kingdom, and all the dominions will serve and obey Him. - Daniel 7:27

God has placed inside mankind a longing for long life and immortality. Man was originally born to live forever in God's presence as heirs in His kingdom.
