WHAT IS MED-ARB?

Med-Arb, which stands for Mediation-Arbitration is a process in which the Mediator attempts to settle the dispute in mediation, and if unsuccessful, proceeds to resolve the dispute through arbitration by making a final binding decision.

WHAT ARE THE ADVANTAGES OF USING MED-ARB INSTEAD OF LITIGATION?

As Med-Arb is a hybrid dispute resolution method, combining mediation and arbitration, this approach offers several advantages over litigation which include reaching a resolution faster than going to court, a reduction in overall cost, and greater flexibility, i.e. scheduling that meets your needs rather than mandatory appearances in court.
