Price Increase at Swiss Park

Many of you will have already noticed the change in the amount Boots 'N Buckles is charging for our Friday Night Dances. We would like to provide you with a little history so you will understand how the change came about.

Two months ago Swiss Park changed hands and our board was informed that the rate we were to be charged for renting the hall would be raised by almost 600%. Over the next several weeks various attempts were made to negotiate this price change. The board agreed that our former rental price was way too low, but did not like this gigantic increase. All proposals were turned down, as well as our attempts to receive any concessions such as set-up of the room, or improved ventilation. The president and board members spent many hours working on this problem.

After much discussion, the board decided that we would be forced to go along with the proposed change. The board agreed that the dance floor is excellent, the location is good, and we like it here.

Therefore, the only solution was to agree to the cost increase. This cost is now reflected in the amount we are charging for dances. The cost of the dance for members is now \$4.00 and for non-members, \$5.00.

The Boots 'N Buckles board feels this is still a good price for the opportunity to have the fun of dancing on Friday nights.

Swiss Park Dance Lessons

As you may know by now, the Boots 'N' Buckles Dance Club has had to increase their price for the Friday Night Dances by \$2.00. This change is a direct reflection of the increase in rent by our landlords at Swiss Park.

This increase in rent affects the Monday and Wednesday night Dance Classes as well. We, Charlotte & Neil, are faced with a difficult decision to consider the discontinuance of our dance classes or to raise our prices. It has always been our objective to offer the best bargain in Dance Classes at the lowest possible price, but because of the nearly 600% increase imposed by the Swiss Park board, we find it regretfully necessary to raise our price from \$3.00 to \$4.00 for Adults. There will be no change for Children and Sr. Adults. We hope this change will be acceptable to you, our students, and we apologize for any inconvenience it may cause you. We look forward to your continued interest in the future.

Again, prices will be as follows:

ADULTS - \$4.00 (\$1.00 change)
SR. ADULTS _____ \$1.00 (no change)
CHILDREN \$1.00 (no change)

This change will become effective on AUGUST 2, 1989.
