The Treasurer Sez . . . Well, half the year has already flown by, and the 4th Annual Boots N Buckles Dance Workshop is a thing of the past. As expected, the workshop put the club finances back in the black with a profit of \$1,442.93, so it was a great success any way you want to look at it.

If you don't count the fact that we paid rent twice in June, we ended the month with a profit of \$121.51. You are probably thinking that that doesn't seem like much considering the workshop was such a success. You have to remember however, that most of our workshop revenue came in during the months of April and May, but all of our expenses for the workshop fell in the month of June. For the year-to-date figure, the club has made a profit of \$330.33.

All things considered, June was a great month, and I hope all of you will mark June 2nd on your 2001 calendar, as that is the date for next year s workshop. Let 's keep those feet dancing.


