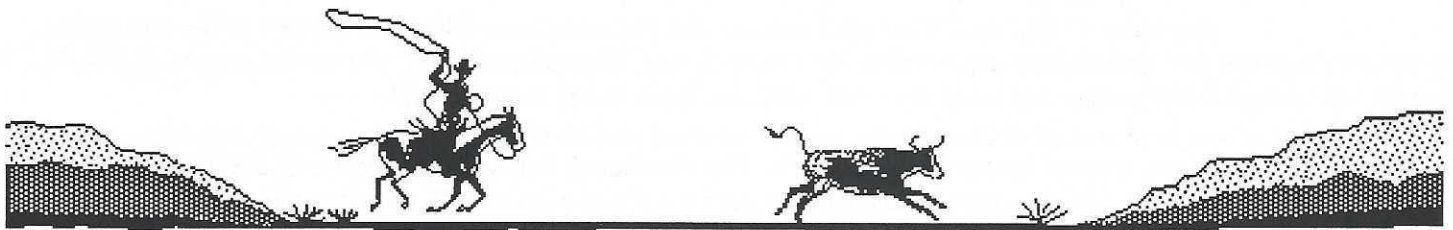

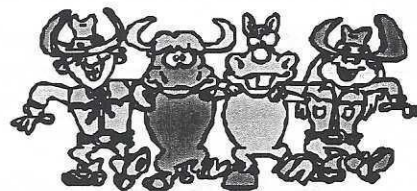

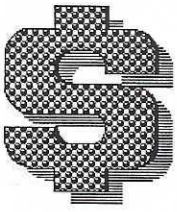

DID YA ALL KNOW that PacBell Park in SF was chosen #6 of the best 10 ballparks?? Hi everyone! Here is the treasurer's report for June. It will be short. I know facts and figures can be boring reading material, but please bear with me.

First and foremost the annual workshop proved to be a great success!!!! 104 tickets were sold totaling \$2,392.00. Additional revenues from the Saturday night dance, 50/50 raffle and the \$100 bill raffle brought in an additional \$325.00 bringing the grand total to \$2,717.00. (Remember, some of these revenues were deposited in prior months)

Expenses of \$1,702.55 included some of the following: one-\$100 bill, 50/50 raffle, hall rental, programs/packets, DJ, instructors and goodies for the grab bag. Overall profit for the workshop was \$1,014.45. The profit is nice, but I think what was most important was the "good time" shared by all.

The club also had four dances in June. Attendance was small due to it being summer. When the expenses were paid, the dances actually showed losses for the month. The checkbook balance right now is \$12,870.50. This total includes rent already paid for July and the deposit for next year's workshop. I'll talk about the shirts & jackets in July's report.

That's my report for this month. Keep dancing!

MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL . . .

Howdy Dancers,

It may seem a little early, but it's that time of year again...time to renew your **membership** to the Boots 'n' Buckles dance club. Your current membership and subscription to the Roundup expires at the end of September. We run the membership year from October 1st through September 30th because the insurance premium is due in November. To determine the rate, we must provide the number of members and a list of their names along with the per-person fee and a processing fee. It'll take me a couple of weeks to assemble the list, fill in and file the forms. Each time we add members we pay the per-person fee and an additional processing fee. You can save the club money by renewing your membership before September 30, 2002.

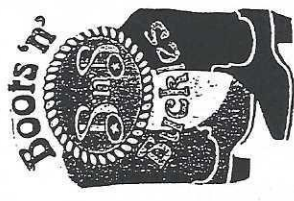

HOW TO SURVIVE A HEART ATTACK ALONE

Let's say it's 6:15 p.m. and you're driving home (alone of course), after an unusually hard day on the job. You're really tired, upset and frustrated. Suddenly you start experiencing severe pain in your chest that starts to radiate out into your arm and up into your jaw. You are only about five miles from the hospital nearest your home; unfortunately you don't know if you'll be able to make it that far. What can you do? You've been trained in CPR but the guy that taught the course neglected to tell you how to perform it on yourself. Since many people are alone when they suffer a heart attack, this article seemed to be in order.

Without help, the person whose heart stops beating properly and who begins to feel faint, has only about 10 seconds left before losing consciousness. However, these victims can help themselves by coughing repeatedly and very vigorously. A deep breath should be taken before each cough. The cough must be deep and prolonged, as when producing sputum from deep inside the chest. And a cough must be repeated about every 2 seconds without let up until help arrives, or until the heart is felt to be beating normally again.

Deep breaths get oxygen into the lungs and coughing movements squeeze the heart and keep the blood circulating. The squeezing pressure on the heart also helps it regain normal rhythm. In this way, heart attack victims can get to a hospital.
