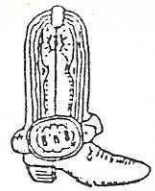

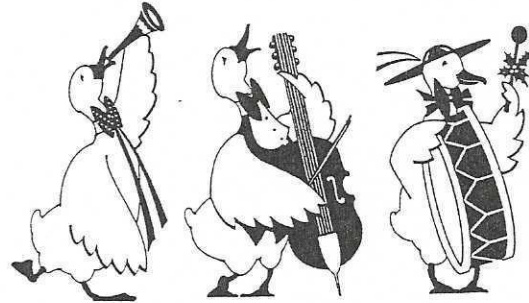


Dance Coupon
