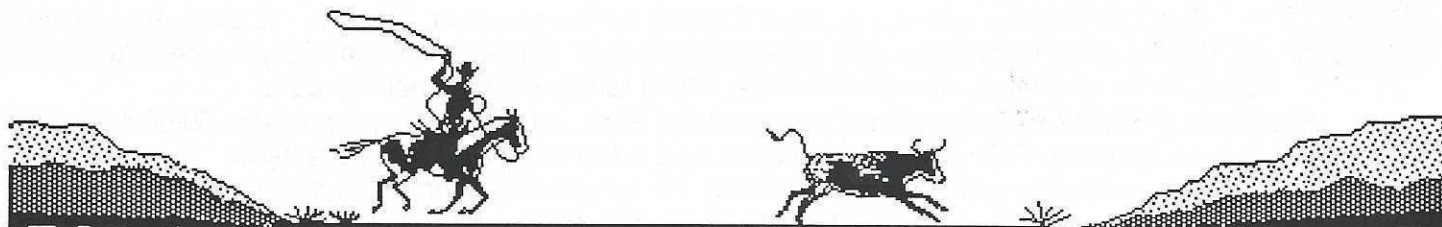

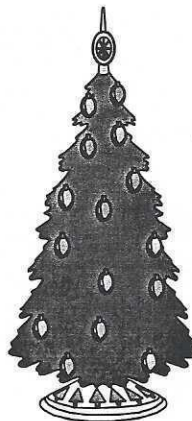

Boots 'N Buckles netted a profit of \$304.03 for the month of October. Total revenues were \$3,122.00 which included money collected from four dances, rent from Gary & Connie's classes, tickets to the annual X-mas dinner/dance, 50/50 raffle, and membership dues.

Expenses of \$2,817.97 included rent paid to Swiss Park, music, printing & postage, 50/50 raffle, and the annual insurance fee to the Folk Dance Federation, and a few other miscellaneous items.

The checkbook has a healthy balance of \$12,598.98. I'll have more information next month on the ticket sales for the X-mas dinner/dance and the McDonald's "After School Snack Pack" fundraiser.

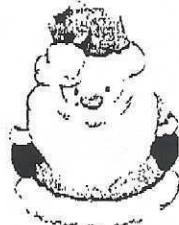
