## FINANCIAL UPDATE

At the January Board meeting it was decided to inform club members of the financial situation faced by Boots 'N' Buckles. The following information is provided by the club treasurer:

---

### MONTHLY INFORMATION

In 1990 the average monthly dance receipts were \$2,374.00

Average monthly expenses for dance hall, music and door were \$2,279.00

---

### ANNUAL INFORMATION

Total income from dance receipts, sub-lease of hall, advanced ticket sales, membership dues was - - -\$36,083.00

Total expenses for insurance, music, newsletter, name tags, jackets, decorations, charity, club incorporation, taxes, door, picnic, food, banking fees, miscellaneous supplies and dance instructors was \$37,428.00

We spent \$1,345.00 more than we took in. This was money carried over from the previous year.

This year we will be looking to reduce our expenses so that we do not have to increase our dance admission. Also, please remember that dance attendance makes a big difference in our income per month. Please support your club, it's the best bargain going and without your support in Membership and dance attendance the club will cease to exist as we now know it.
