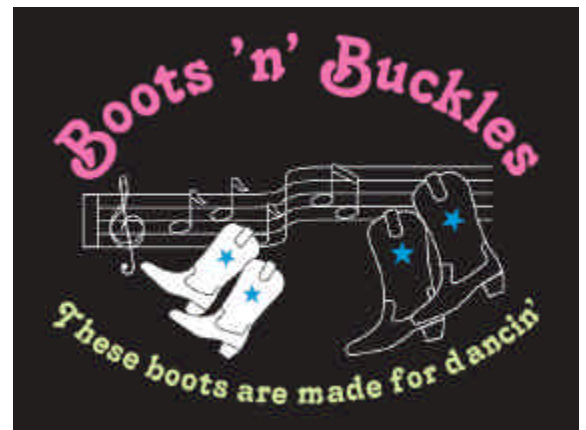
### ***Boots 'n' Buckles Workshop T-shirts***

A mother is four times as old as her daughter. In 20 years she will be twice as old as her daughter.

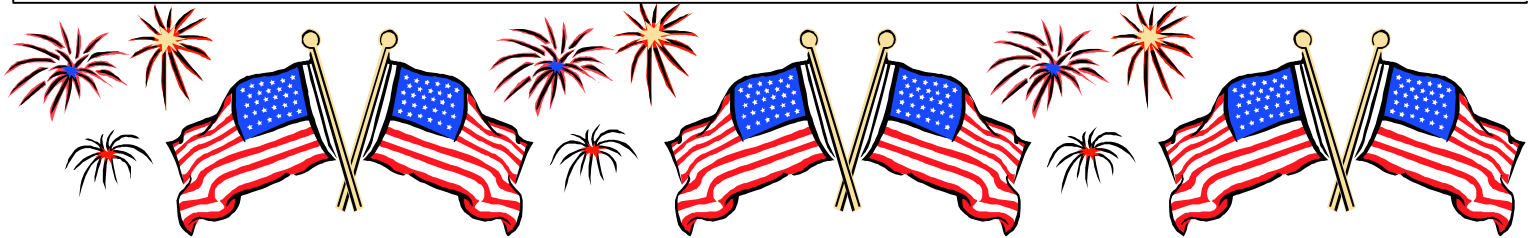

## Treasurer's Report - Overview for June 2006

Below are the financial statements for the club as of June 24, 2006. After including all of the revenues and expenses for the workshop held on June 17, 21st, the club has made a small year-to-date net income of \$82. While net dance income is running a modest loss of \$242 for the year, the June workshop's \$1,009 net income not only covered this loss, but it also covered the April spaghetti feed.

The club's cash position remains strong with \$10,000 in a risk-free CD earning 4.00% APR and over \$1,600 in cash and checking.
