Recently, though, the Board of Directors at Swiss Park has warned us that, if certian things go uncorrected, we may not be able to continue there. These, of course, are very justifiable concerns and they will require the co-operation of all of us if we are to continue.

Please therefore:

- 1. <u>Do not bring any food or drink into Swiss</u> Park unless they are bought at the bar.
- 2. Do not drop children off or leave them unattended at dance lessons.
- 3. Do not allow children or those under 21 years of age into the bar area or parking lot, except for passing through or males using the restroom.
- 4. Also, if you are returning to the bar area, please bus empty glasses and bottles back to the bar to insure an adequate supply of glasses. Do not throw bottles in trash can as they must be accounted for.

Please be advised that this situation pertains only to Monday and Wednesday evening lessons and has nothing to do with Friday night dances - although I'm sure the same rules apply.

Your continued support in adhering to these rules is absolutely necessary if we are to continue using Swiss Park for our dance lessons.
