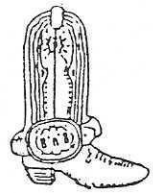

Put this on your calendars now! SUNDAY, AUGUST 13, for an afternoon at Buck Norred Ranch in South San Jose.

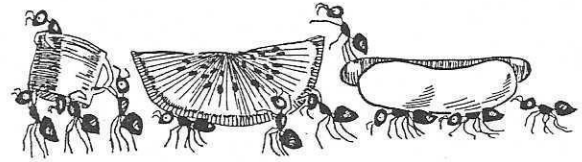
