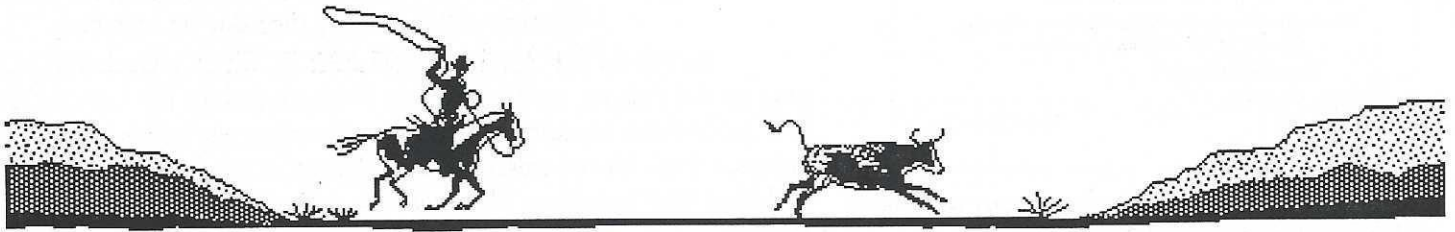

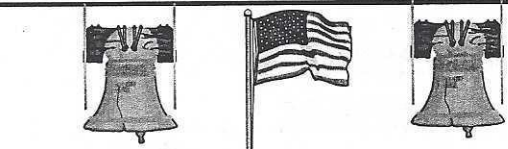
Dolores received the sweatshirts and T-shirts. I really like my sweatshirt with the BootsN'Buckles logo on it. We will have them on display and will be taking orders.

In 1924, President Coolidge recommended that the states, if they wished, should hold their own Father's Day observances. In 1957, Senator Margaret Smith wrote to the congress that we should honor both parents - not to single out one. It wasn't until 1972 that Father's Day was permanently established by President Nixon. Today, Father's Day is the 5th largest card-selling occasion!!

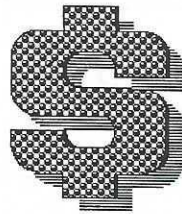

RENEWAL . . .



Where has this year gone already? It's almost the end of May which means summer is fast approaching...warm days (I hope), BBQ's, picnics, lazy days in the park, and our Annual Boots 'N' Buckles workshop on June 1st. Be ready to "ice down" the soles of your feet after all the dancing we'll be doing that day and evening.

Revenues for April were \$3,222.13, which included admission to the dances, rent paid to us from Charlotte for her classes, and \$897 from tickets sold for the upcoming workshop. More revenue from ticket sales will be included in May's report. It also included approximately \$51 from the sale of Sees candy sold at Easter.

Expenses for the month were \$2,823.72. The largest expense, of course, was the rent paid to Swiss Park. Other larger expenses included music \$700, raffle \$209, and a well deserved D. bonus of \$300. The monthly profit for April was \$398.41, and as it stands right now our checkbook balance is \$13,662.90.

Hope you have a great Memorial Day weekend. As for myself I'm going canoeing/fishing on the Brule River in Wisconsin. I'm crossing my fingers that I don't get dunked by the canoe like I did a few weeks ago! Keep on dancing!!!!!!

Howdy Dancers,

It may seem a little early, but it's that time of year again...time to renew your **membership** to the Boots 'n' Buckles dance club. Your current membership and subscription to the Roundup expires at the end of September. We run the membership year from October 1st through September 30th because the insurance premium is due in November. To determine the rate, we must provide the number of members and a list of their names along with the per-person fee and a processing fee. It'll take me a couple of weeks to assemble the list, fill in and file the forms. Each time we add members we pay the per-person fee and an additional processing fee. You can save the club money by renewing your membership before September 30, 2002.

The dues this year remain at \$18.00. 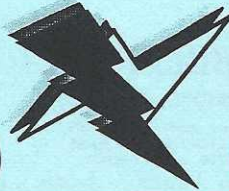

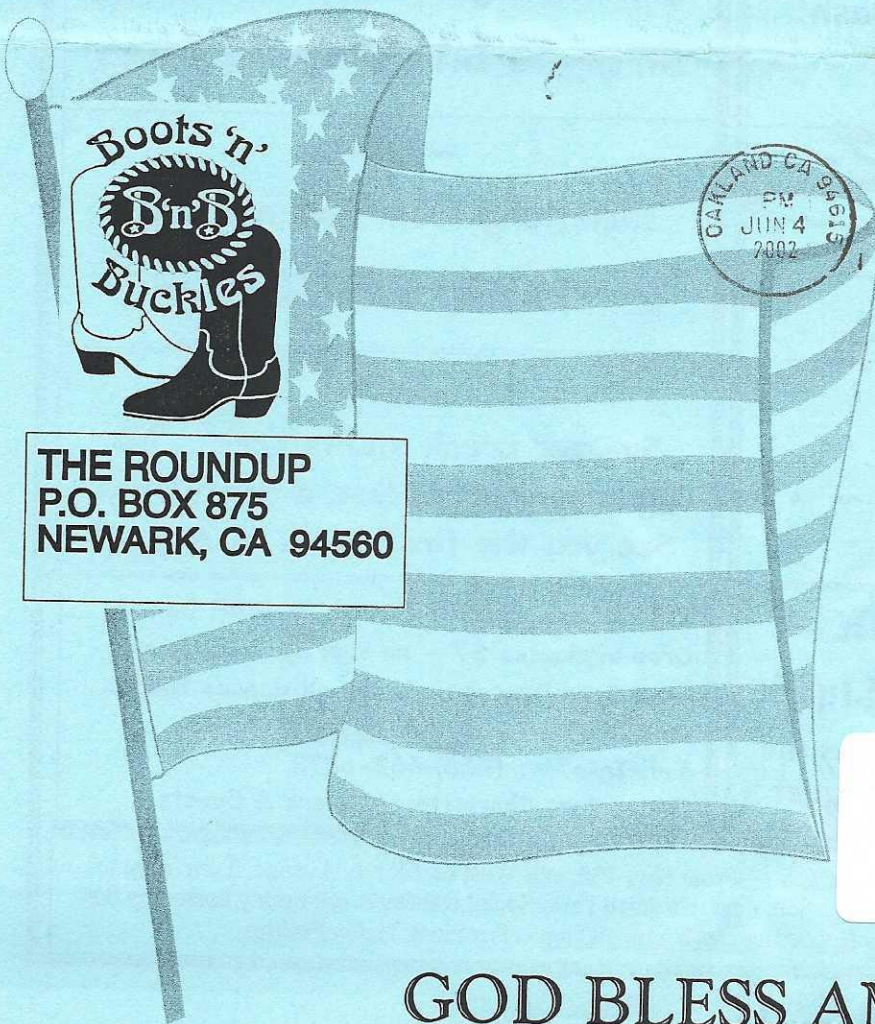
