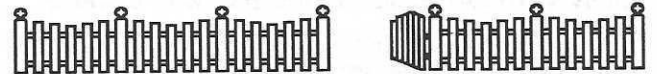
### President's message

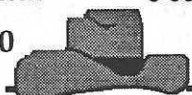

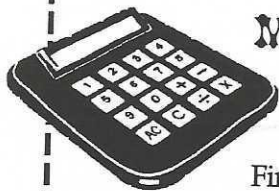

## MARCH TREASURER'S REPORT

First of all I want to say how relieved I am to have the club's taxes done. Hip hip hooray!!! The not so fun news is that dance revenues were down in March. The club lost \$168 on the dances, but our shirt and workshop ticket sales helped the club recognize an overall profit of \$389.64 for the month. Thus far we have \$638 in workshop ticket sales, and the budget for the workshop is approximately \$1570, so we are almost half way towards meeting our workshop expenses. Even though our workshop ticket sales are progressing nicely, our year-to-date operating figure is a loss of \$157 for the first quarter of 2000. That said, I am confident that our workshop is going to be a very fun and profitable event that will bolster the club's financial health through the rest of the year.
