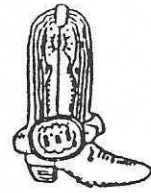

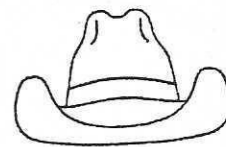
Quick Steppers
