It was nice to see so many dancers dressed up in their Hawaiian shirts on the second Friday night dance. There were several very nice leis and hair flowers. Good job.



On our bootsnbucklesdanceclub.com website are the financial statements for the club as of August 31, 2006.

The club has realized a surplus of \$740 year-to-date. This unusually high surplus is due to current membership renewal fees.

The club's cash position remains strong with \$10,090 in a risk-free CD earning 4.00% APR and over \$1,900 in cash and checking. – Gary Davidson, Treasurer

QUICK APPLE DUMPLING

2 pkg crescent rolls

2 large apples Cut into eight pieces each (the original recipe did not say whether or not to peel the apples - I did when I made it - and I used Granny Smith apples.)

Roll each apple piece into each crescent roll - place single file in a 9x13 cake pan.

Take:

1 cup sugar

1 tbsp. cinnamon

1 stick butter

Crumble together. Sprinkle mixture over apple and crescent rolls in pan. Pour 10 oz of Mountain Dew over all of crescent rolls.

Bake at 375 degrees for thirty-five minutes.

Serve warm with ice cream.

This is a wonderfully, delicious recipe that is easier to make than you can imagine and it will bring more compliments than you ever thought possible. Friends will think you cooked for hours when you serve this one.
