

Expect the Miraculous (sjm 4-21-2024)

Purpose of church: to worship God, fellowship w/others & be instructed by God: **Pastor:** Find Godly solutions to problems
Miraculous – means divine, supernatural intervention by God or manifesting to us such power

1 Cor 2:4 And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power.

⁵ That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.

Normal Vincent Peale – Those that keep your eyes open expectedly every day for wonderful things to happen - will see wonderful things happen! **"Expect a Miracle"** If you expect great things from God you will get great things and vice versa.

Mark 9:23 Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, **all things are possible** to him that believeth.

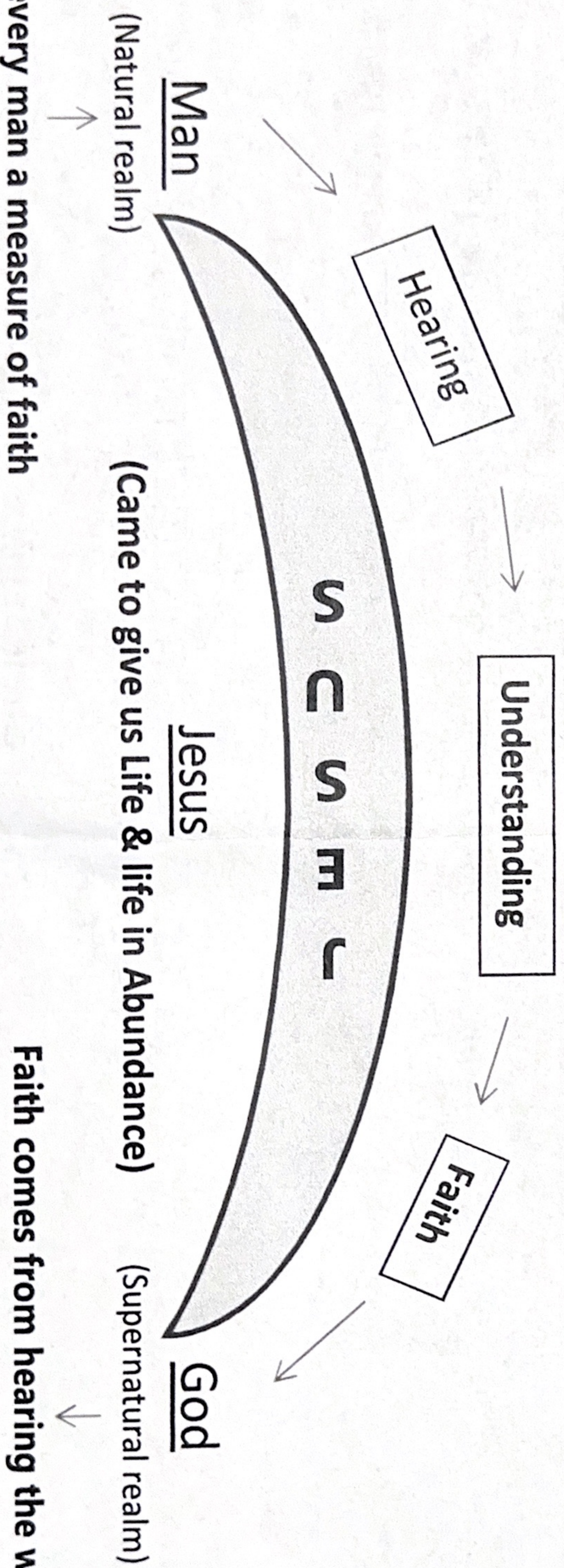
Matt 19:26 ... With men this is impossible; but with God **all things are possible**.

Jesus did many things that were miraculous – turned water into wine, walked on water, calmed violent storms, cursed fig trees, raised the dead, walked right threw a crowd, transported to the other side of sea, healed the blind, lame and paralyzed.

These were **Supernatural** suspension of the ordinary course of nature: **An Overriding** of the ordinary course of nature.
God can override any adverse circumstance in your life!

Job 9:33 I wish there was a **mediator** or **arbitrator** between us to bring us together. (Jesus)

1 Tim 2:5 For there is one God, and one **mediator** between God and men, the man Christ Jesus; **Heb 8:6** of a better covenant on better promises



Two Powerful Scriptures to walk in the Miraculous:

Ps 103:1 Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless his holy name.

² Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits:



³ Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases;

⁴ Who redeemeth thy life from destruction = (CONDITIONS BEYOND REPAIR)

⁴ Who crowneth thee with lovingkindness and tender mercies?

⁵ Who satisfieth your desires with good things, so that thy youth is renewed like the eagles.

Gal 4:1 Now I say, That the heir, as long as he is a child, (*nepios*), differeth nothing from a servant, though he be lord of all;

² But is under tutors and governors until the time appointed of the father.

³ Even so we, when we were children, were in bondage under the elements of the world:

⁴ But when the fullness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law,

⁵ To redeem them those were under the law, that we might receive the **adoption of sons**.
