

What To Do When Faith Seems Weak & Victory Lost (4-6-2022)

Our Motto: Good God and Bad Devil: (God blesses you & Satan curses you)

Step 1: Recognize the Source of Your Opposition (3 possibilities)
[EITHER GOD, SATAN OR YOUR SELF] Jer 29:11 proves it is not God

Eph 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against (1) principalities and (2) powers, against (3) rulers of the darkness of this world and against (4) spiritual wickedness in high places.

- (1) fallen angels
- (2) one who possesses authority "angelic beings"
- (3) literally world rulers of darkness, "age" = worlds system
- (4) spirit forces of evil in the heavenlies

Ref: Eph 2:2 Where in **times past** ye walked according to the course of this world (age), according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that **now worketh** in the children of disobedience

2 Cor 4:4 In whom the God of this world (age), has blinded the minds of them that believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine upon them.

John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
More Abundant (in the sense of beyond); superabundant (in quantity) or superior (in quality); by implication, excessive "to give an advantage"

1 Peter 5:8 Be sober, be **vigilant**; because your adversary (opponent/enemy) the devil, as a roaring lion, **walketh about**, seeking whom he may **devour**;

Sober = to watch (in the natural realm)

Vigilant = to be spiritually awake

Waketh About = his main job

Devour = to swallow up knowledge (Satan cometh immediately to steal word sown in you)

Matt 26:41 Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation: the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.

Luke 13:16 & ought not this woman being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan has bound low,

Rem: Matt 16:17-19 to bring revelation knowledge (then binding & loosing)

1 John 4:4 Ye are of God little children & have **overcome** him, (Spirit of Anti-Christ), for **greater** is he that is in thee than he that is in the world

Overcome = subdued, conquered, prevailed, got the victory

Greater = greater or larger
