

MBGC Code of Conduct: June 2025.

MBGC requires all members to treat other members, course staff and members of the public with respect by any medium: physical - face to face, written, telephone, or electronic. All communication with third parties relating to the clubs golfing matters will assume to be made on a personal basis and unless stated specifically will not reflect the views of the Club or its elected officials. Any communication exchanged between members or the club's officials and members must be dealt with in confidence and not shared with third parties whatsoever without the express permission of the author.

In addition, all members are expected to uphold R&A and club competition rules as published on the club website, and to uphold the clubs Equality, Diversity & Inclusion policy. Penalty for breach of this code will be determined by the Committee and sanctions will range from Formal warning to suspension from participation in club events.

Specifically, failure to submit or incorrect scores submitted:

First Occasion - formal warning of future sanctions.

Second Occasion – ineligibility to enter next qualifying competition.

Third & Subsequent occasions will be considered a serious breach of Code of Conduct - Disqualification from competition and ineligibility to enter future competitions for 2 to 4 weeks at the committee's discretion.
