NRA BASIC PISTOL & RIFLE COURSES

\$125.00 per-student (8-hours)

Safety skills when handling and shooting, reloading, malfunction drills, using a holster, defensive shooting in close quarters, safe storage in the home, determining the right firearm for you and concealment methods. Client will learn proper cleaning techniques for the firearm(s). Client is responsible for own ammunition and firearms used. Firearms in the calibers of 9mm, .357, .40, and .45 can be rented from the instructor. AR15 can be rented. Completion card awarded.
