### Hello to all the newsletter readers of West Hempfield Presbyterian Church!

This year the season of Advent (4 Sundays before Christmas) began on November 30.

"Advent" means "coming," "arrival," or "appearance." In Advent we count down the days and we prepare for the coming of the Messiah on Christmas Day.

In many ways Advent is the beginning of something new. The beginning of a new church calendar year. The beginning of the New Testament stories. The beginning of the Christian church's story with the arrival of the baby Jesus in Bethlehem.

In many ways, though, Advent is also a continuation. A new chapter, perhaps, but the same story. God of the New Testament is the same God of the Old Testament. Old Testament stories point ahead to the coming of Jesus the Messiah as well. The Gospel of John even tells us that Jesus, the living Word of God who is made flesh at Christmas, (John 1:2-3a) *He was with God in the beginning. Through Him all things were made.* 

This Advent at WHPC we also have a new beginning, that is also just a continuation. A new chapter, perhaps, but the same story.

My job responsibilities are shifting. Our worship start time is shifting. A few more volunteers are needed in the office. But, now alongside the First UCC of Irwin whose financial support allows us to keep doing what we're doing, I am still preaching the good news of Jesus Christ (twice each Sunday, like the good old days) and we are still worshiping the Creator of Heaven and Earth every Sunday.

### TEXT MESSAGE COMMUNICATION

If you have not already, you can text "Hello" to (833) 390 - 9010 to sign up for WHPC text message announcements. (Be sure to give your name when prompted so we know it's you.)

Gloo, a free program for smaller churches like our own, allows the church to send "broadcast style text messages" to everyone who signs up.

We will not be filling your phone with hundreds of messages, and you can always text STOP at any time to be removed. The plan is to use this for reminders (like Poinsettia orders are due Wednesday December 3) and surprise changes (like winter weather cancellations).

It is not just one-way communication! You can also send a text to the same number with questions or prayer requests. All messages are visible to Pastor Andrew, and we can text you back right through the program. So be sure to add WHPC's unique number (833) 390 - 9010 to your contacts as West Hempfield Presbyterian Church for text messages.
