# Hello to all the newsletter readers of West Hempfield Presbyterian Church!

Since this is the August newsletter, you are probably reading it in August. However, as I am working on it, I am attending the New Wilmington Mission

Conference, on the campus of Westminster College, New Wilmington, PA.

The theme for this year's conference is "Be strong and courageous" from Joshua 1:9.

If we continue reading verse 9, it goes on to say "Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go."

"Do not be afraid" is the most common command in all of Scripture and, according to our keynote speaker Nana Yaw Offei Awuku, it is also the easiest command to fail.

When God saves us, God does not take away our emotions. Just because we have decided to follow Jesus, that does not mean we will never be afraid again.

The Lord knows that we need to be encouraged everyday. That is why Scripture repeats it so often.

To an audience of over 300 people from all generations, our speaker Nana also encouraged us all by reminding us "What makes you afraid, does not scare God."

Over and over again, when Scriptures says "Do not be afraid," God follows it with some version of "because I am with you."

Nana said it this way, "God is the *I-am-with-you* God."

Our strength and courage comes from the Lord.

Through Scripture God tells us that life is and will be difficult, even if we choose to follow God—sometimes life is difficult because we chose to follow God.

And through it all, God is with us.

In the midst of the storms of life, it makes perfect sense to be afraid.

But we are not alone. We are in the presence of God. God will be with us wherever we go.

Do you need strength today? Are you in the midst of the storms of life? Feeling tossed about and out of control? Overwhelmed? Tired?

Strength comes from the Lord.

Are you standing at a crossroad? Uncertain what comes next? Hesitant to take the next step? Be courageous to follow Jesus, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go.
