Hello to all the newsletter readers of West Hempfield Presbyterian Church!

On Sunday, April 25 we started our sermon series to promote Vacation Bible School. The Armor of God will tie our sermons together as it sets the stage for **Knights of North Castle** and the Search for the King's Armor.

As I am preparing these messages and reading the VBS Bible stories, it strikes me that an alternate theme for VBS could have been *Immanuel—God with us!*

Daniel 3 — God was with Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego in the Blazing Furnace

I Samuel 17 — God was with David as he stood up against Goliath

Luke 2:1-20 — God was with Mary as she traveled to Bethlehem and she gave birth to Jesus, the one who will be called Immanuel, God with us

Matthew 14:22-33 — God was with Peter as he walked on water, and when he became afraid and started to sink, Jesus reached out his hand and caught him.

Acts 16:16-40 — God was with Paul and Silas, even when they were imprisoned, giving them the confidence to pray and sing hymns to God in a situation that could otherwise be terrifying

In whatever situation you find yourself today, know that God is with you! The promise of Immanuel is written through all of Scripture.

[Jesus said] "And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age."



APRIL SESSION HIGHLIGHTS



The Session of West Hempfield Presbyterian Church met on April 27, 2021

- Together we covered our church and congregation with prayer, read Scripture, and reviewed all that has been going on with the church and the world.
- For the first time in over a year, everyone was at the church; no one attended on Zoom
- Read and reflected on John 10:1-10
- Responsibilities of the clerk continue to be shared. If you have something for the clerk, please contact the church office or Pastor Andrew.
- The Session declined to make any official statements or rules regarding COVID as circumstances and guidance still seem to change frequently enough that any statement would likely be outdated as soon as it was made. We are, however, doing our best to follow the news and guidance.
- As such, there are currently no churchwide rules regarding masks, distancing, singing, etc beyond public guidelines. The Session encourages everyone to follow current guidelines as you are able and as they apply to your situation. Individuals and groups will need to make choices for themselves based on their own circumstances and risk assessments. Respect should be shown to one another in every case understanding that different circumstances may lead to different choices and practices.
- The upstairs kitchen will be set up, starting Mother's Day May 9, as a space for fellowship on Sunday mornings for those who are comfortable. Coffee, tea, and water will be available. Respecting those who may not be comfortable with this step yet, we ask that the fellowship and refreshments stay in the kitchen for now. As comfort and participation grows, we expect it will return to the lobby, but not before proper announcements to make everyone aware.
- Communion starting now (May 2) will be distributed by an elder after the sermon as part of the worship service. We will continue using single-serve, pre-packaged communion cups for now.
- Sunday School program will take a summer break. Last Sunday School class will be May 16 and will be a party for the students and opportunity to spend their Glory Gold.
- Vacation Bible School will be Knights of North Castle, June 14-18. Registration is open. Volunteers needed. VBS Sunday will be June 20, 2021
- Approval was given for Tony to use the sanctuary for a recital for his students.
