Hello to all the newsletter readers of West Hempfield Presbyterian Church!

As many of you know, I was honored to serve as a Commissioner to the General Assembly (GA) of the r. DODAN OF THE P SALT L SALT L PCUSA held in Salt Lake City, UT this summer.

The General Assembly is the onceevery-two-years gathering for the business of the national denomination.

A three day committee meeting followed by a four day session meeting for the whole PCUSA.

In my sermons throughout August and a little into September, I will be sharing about what happened at GA and some of my reflections on it.

What gets the most attention is usually the proposed changes to our Book of Order and/or things that spend money (i.e. affect per capita). But not everything we did at the 226th General Assembly changes our Book of Order, spends money, or requires churches to do something.

You might ask then, "Why is it important?"

Remember, even though we are shrinking, the PCUSA still represents over 8,500 churches and over 1 million members. We have a lot of influence!

The PCUSA has a presence in both Washington, DC, and the United Nations, advocating for the policies and positions discussed at GA. When the PCUSA speaks at GA, it makes waves throughout the world.

This year, we promoted a paper titled "More Than Knowledge and Training" that addresses the purpose and value of a college or university education and

the rising cost of higher education and student indebtedness (this one came through my committee, Christian Formation).

We spoke against the use of prolonged solitary confinement (recognized as a form of torture by

> the UN) and voiced support for removing the 13th Amendment's exception that permits those who are convicted of a crime to be enslaved.

> > We discussed the threat of climate change and debated appropriate responses.

We called for action so that children may live free from gun violence.

Over the last few years, many in the PCUSA (including Redstone Presbytery) have sought to embrace Jesus' words in Matthew 25, "whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me."

I was moved by the ways the GA followed the calling of Jesus by drawing attention to, and speaking up for, "the least of these."
