In no fewer than 500 words, write about a person, place or event in Pike County history.

Be creative in choosing your topic. It should be a little-known subject or an aspect of a well-known subject. Correct grammar and punctuation are expected but content is most important. You must credit any sources used. The scholarship will be awarded based on the correct and creative use of historical information.

Essay must be typed in a legible font at 1.5 or 2 spacing. Include your name and the title of your essay on the first page and please number your pages.

Essays submitted will be kept at the East School Museum. The winning essay will also be posted on our Facebook page and website along with a photo of the winner unless the applicant does not give us permission to do so as indicated on the form.
