WELCOME TO PARASHA #14 OF THE TORAH: IT MEANS: AND I SHOWED MYSELF

We will continue to learn about what happened in the time of slavery of the people of Yisrael in Mitzrayim. Moshe and Aaron appeared before the Paró (Pharaoh) and increased their forced labor, however, YAHWEH reminds them of what he has done and what he will do in fulfillment of the promise from Abraham.

Moshe appeared before Pharaon the times they were necessary to ask him to let the people of Israel leave Mitzrayim, Moshe was 80 years old and Aaron 83 years old when they showed up before him. The Eternal told them that when he stopped he would tell them: - "Make miracles, provide some wonder" Aaron will take his rod and throw it before him so that it becomes a snake, and he did so. However, the sorcerers and wizards of the Pharaon did the same with their rods, with the only and great difference that Aaron's rod swallowed their rods. Impressive! But as YAHWEH had said, Pharaon hardened his heart and did not want to let the people of Yisrael go.

Because of this, the Eternal sent 10 plagues on Mitzrayim, affecting only the inhabitants of Mitzrayim but the people of Yisrael were always safe. We invite you to continue studying the parasha and you will know what these plagues were.

SHEMOT / EXODUS 6: 2-5, 28-30

2Elohim spoke to Moshe, he said to him: 'I am YAHWEH.

- 3 I appeared to Avraham, Yitzjak and Ya'akov as El Shaddai, didn't I make myself known to them by My Name, Yud-Heh-Vav-Heh [YAHWEH]?
- 4 I also established with them my Covenant to give them the land of Kenaan, the land where they wandered from here and there and dwelt as foreigners.
- 5 Moreover, I have heard the groan of the sons of Yisra'el, whom the Mitzrayimim have in slavery; and I have remembered my Covenant.
- 6 'Therefore, I said to the children of Yisra'el: 'I am YAHWEH. I will free them from the burdensome work of the Mitzrayimim, I will rescue them from their oppression, and I will redeem them with an outstretched arm and with great judgments.
- 28 On the day that YAHWEH spoke to Moshe in the land of Mitzrayim,
- 29 He said: 'I am YAHWEH. Tell Pharaoh king of Mitzrayim everything I say to you.' °
- 30 Moshe answered YAHWEH: 'Look, I am such a poor speaker that Pharaoh will not listen to me.'

SHEMOT / EXODUS 7: 1-4, 8-13

- 1 But YAHWEH said to Moshe, 'I have put you in the place of Elohim for Pharaoh, and Aharon your brother will be your prophet. °
- 2 You shall say all that I command you, and Aharon your brother will speak to Pharaoh and tell him to let the children of Yisra out of his land. °
- 3 But I will give it back with a hard heart. Although I will increase my signs and wonders in the land of Mitzrayim,
- 4 Pharaoh will not listen to you. Then I will put my hands on Mitzrayim and bring my armies, my people, the sons of Yisra'el, out of the land of Mitzrayim with great acts of judgment.
- 8 YAHWEH said to Moshe and Aharon:
- 9 'When Pharaoh says to you, 'Do a miracle,' tell Aharon to take his rod and throw it to the ground in front of Pharaoh, so that he can become a snake.' °
- 10 Moshe and Aharon went before Pharaoh and did this, as YAHWEH had commanded Aharon threw his rod to the ground before Pharaoh and his servants, and became a serpent.
- 11 But Pharaoh in turn commanded his wise men and sorcerers to call, and they too, the magicians of Mitzrayim, did the same, making use of their secret arts. °
- 12 Each one threw his rod to the ground, and they became serpents. But Aharon's rod swallowed theirs.
- 13 However, Pharaoh was turned with a hard heart; he did not listen to them, as YAHWEH had said it would happen.




