**WELCOME TO PARASHA #2 OF THE TORAH
NOAJ WHICH MEANS: NOAH**

In this parsha we will learn about the Eternal's call to Noah, a righteous man at a time consumed by violence and sin to build an ark (teiva) covered with tar inside and outside because a great flood would come. Elohim said he will eliminate all life from the earth, but the ark will float in the water, protecting the life of Noah, his family, and the animals. The rain falls for 40 days and nights, the waters flow for 150 more days before starting to dry up. The ark perches on Mount Ararat and to prove that they could go out, Noah sends a raven, and then a series of doves, "to see if the waters have gone off the face of the earth.

When the land dried up completely, Elohim instructs Noah to come out of the teivah and repopulate the land. Noah builds an altar and offers sacrifices to Elohim. Elohim vows never again to destroy all mankind because of his actions, and establishes the arch as a testimony to his new covenant with man. Noah receives further instruction from Elohim on the sanctity of life; Murder is a capital punishment crime, and, while man is permitted to eat the flesh of animals, he is forbidden to eat meat or drink blood taken from a live animal. Noah plants a vineyard and gets drunk on its produce. Two of his sons, Shem and Yaphet, are blessed for covering their father's nakedness, while his third son, Ham, is cursed for taking advantage of his misfortune.

Noah's descendants remain as one people, with a common language and culture for ten generations, but then defy their Creator by building a great tower that symbolizes their invincibility; Elohim did not agree with this and confused their language so that "one does not understand the language of the other," causing them to abandon the building and scatter over the land, separating into seventy nations.

This parsha concludes with the chronology of the ten generations from Noah to Avram (then Avraham), and his journeys from his birthplace in your Kasdim to Haran, on his way to the Land of Kenaan (Canaan).

NOAH BUILDS THE ARK

BERESHIT / GENESIS 6: 9-14, 17-22

9 And these are the generations of Noah. Noah was an upright man and being perfect in his generation, Noah was very pleasing to Elohim.

10 Noah begat three sons, Shem, Ham, and Yepheth.

11 The land was corrupt before Elohim, the land was full of violence.

12 Yahweh Elohim saw the land, and it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted its way upon the earth.

13 And Elohim said to Noah, 'The time of every man has come before me, for because of them the land is full of iniquity. I will destroy them and the earth.'

14 Make yourself a square wooden ark; You will make the ark out of compartments and cover it with pitch inside and out.

17 'Then I Myself will bring the flood of water upon the earth to destroy from under heaven every breathing living thing; Everything on earth will be destroyed.'

18 But I will make a covenant with you; You will enter the ark, you, your children, your wife, and your sons' wives with you.

19 'And of all cattle and of all things that creep and of every wild beast, even of all flesh thou shalt bring in pairs of all, into the ark, that thou mayest feed them with thee; They will be male and female.'

20 From every kind of creature that flies, every kind of breeding animal, in every kind of animal that crawls on the earth, they will come to you in pairs, that they may stay alive.

21 Also take all kinds of food, and gather them for yourself; it will be food for you and for them.'

22 This is what Noah did; he did everything that YAHWEH Elohim commanded him to do.

THE FLOOD

BERESHIT / GENESIS 7: 11-17

11 On the twenty-seventh day of the second month of Noah's 600-year life, all the fountains of the great deep were broken, and the windows of heaven were opened. 12 It rained on the land for forty days and forty nights.

13 On the same day that Noah entered the ark with Shem, Ham, and Yepheth, the sons of Noah, Noah's wife, and the three wives of the sons of Noah who were with them.

14 And of every wild beast of its kind, and of every breeding animal of all kinds, of every creeping thing of all kinds, and of every creature flying of its kind.

15 They went in and went to Noah in the ark, couples of all kinds, all flesh, in whom there is breath of life, as Yahweh commanded Noah.

16 Those who entered, male and female, from all flesh as Yahweh Elohim had commanded them; and Yahweh shut them up within.

17 The flood was forty days in the land; the water rose very high and made the ark float; So it was lifted out of the ground.

GOD'S COVENANT WITH NOAH

BERESHIT / GENESIS 9: 1-4

1 And YAHWEH Elohim blessed Noah and his sons, and said to them, 'Increase and multiply and fill the earth, and have dominion over it.'

2 Fear and dread of you shall be upon every wild beast, every creature that flies in the sky, every creature that swarms the earth, and all the fish of the sea; They have been given to you.

3 Every living thing that moves will be food for you; Just as I gave them green plants before, so now I give them everything -

4 Only flesh with its life, which is its blood, they shall not eat.

THE TOWER OF BABEL

BERESHIT / GENESIS 11: 1-9

1 The whole earth used the same language, the same words.

2 And it came to pass that they traveled from the east, and found a plain in the land of Shinar, and lived there.

3 They said to one another, 'Come, make bricks and bake them in the fire.' So they had bricks for stone and asphalt for mortar.

4 They said, 'Come, let's build a city with a tower that has its top reaching into heaven, so that we can make a name for ourselves so that we won't be scattered on the earth.'

5 And Yahweh came down to see the city and the tower that the people were building.

6 Yahweh said, 'Look, the people have come together, they have one language, and look what they are beginning to do! At this rate, nothing they have set out to do will be impossible for them!'

7 Now therefore let us go down and confound^[44] their language, so that they may not understand each other.'

8 So from there Yahweh scattered them over all the face of the earth, and they stopped building the city and the tower.

9 For this reason it is called Babel [confusion] - because there Yahweh confounded the lips of all the earth, and from there Yahweh scattered them throughout the whole earth.

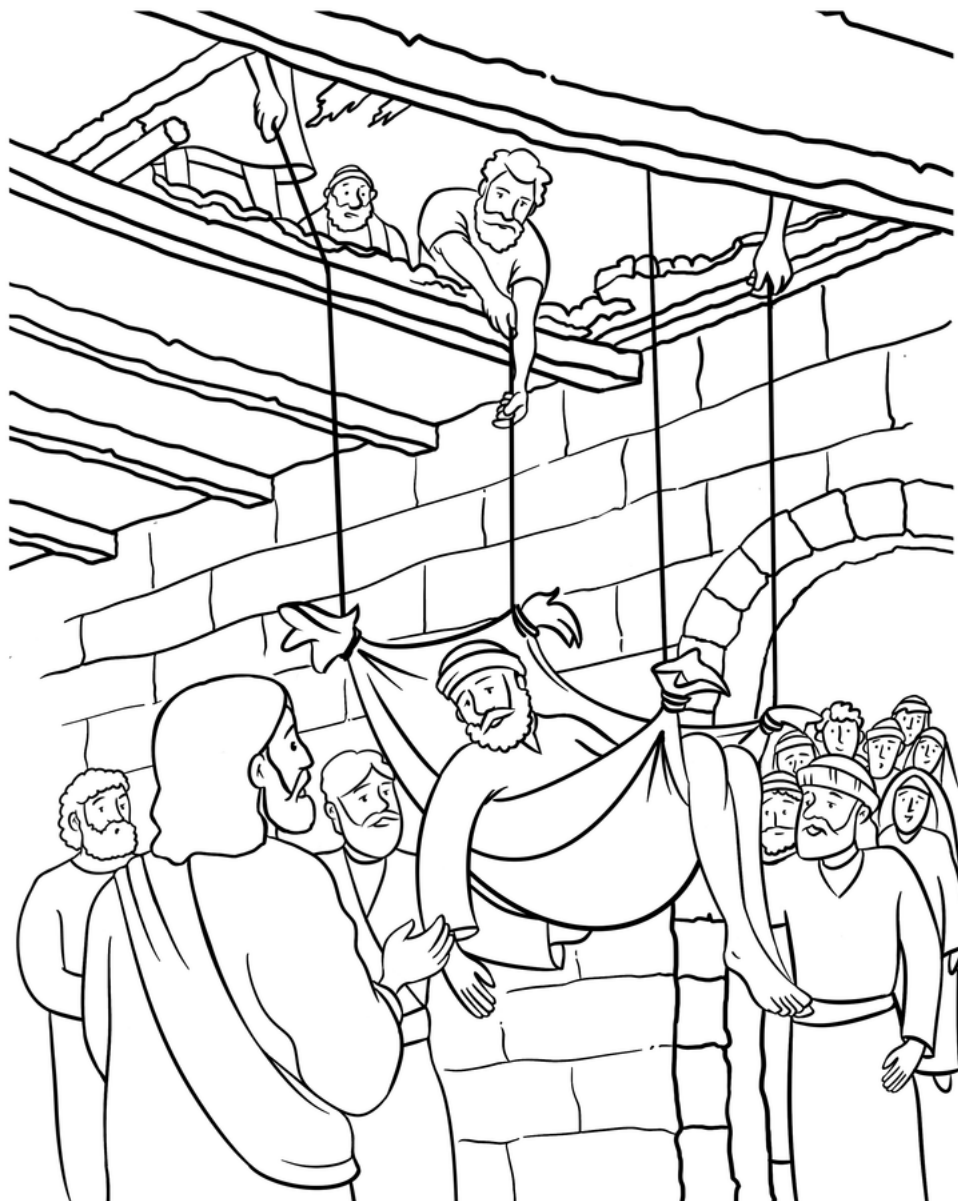


BRIT HADASHÁ
