#### WELCOME TO PARASHA #3 OF THE TORAH LEJ LEJÁ WHICH MEANS: 60 TO YOURSELF

In this parsha we will learn the story of Avram, a man who trusted and obeyed the Eternal by leaving his father's house in the company of his wife Sarai, his nephew Lot, his father and the people who accompanied him from Haran. On that journey they walked for a long time and came to a place where the Eternal made another promise, saying that "All this land that you see will belong to your children and your grandchildren. He was very happy and thanked the Eternal. They kept walking and walking through many places.

During this time walking there was a famine in the land and then Avram went to look for food in a distant country called Mitzrayim (Egypt), he and all his people stayed to live in that country because there was plenty of food there; When they left, Pharaoh gave Avram sheep, cattle, male and female slaves, donkeys and donkeys, and camels.

Then they went up to the Negev with his wife, all that he owned, and Lot. He was very rich in cattle, silver and gold. His nephew Lot also had herds of animals, there were so many animals of Lot and his uncle, that the grass and water were not enough for everyone; Uncle and nephew made a deal: they decided to separate to look for food for their animals, Lot went to a very good place, where there was plenty of pasture and water for his animals: a valley near the city of Sodom and the people there were wicked. Avram stayed to live in the land of Canaan.

Time passed and Avram left that place and went to live somewhere else; Some years later there was a war between several kings and his nephew was taken prisoner of war, along with the people of the place where he lived; When Avram heard what had happened to his nephew, he went away with 318 men, confronted the kings and pursued them, thus recovering his nephew, all his possessions and the people taken prisoner with him.

YAHWEH CALLS AVRAM

#### BERESHIT / GENESIS 12: 1-5

1 Now YAHWEH said to Avram, 'Leave your country, away from your family and away from your father's house, and go to the land that I will show you.

2 I will make you a great nation, I will bless you, I will magnify your name; and you will be blessed.

3 I will bless those who bless you, but I will curse anyone who curses you; and through you all the tribes of the earth will be blessed.'

4 So Avram went out, as Yahweh had told him, and Lot went with him. Avram was 75 years old when he left Haran.

5 Avram took his wife Sarai, his brother's son Lot, and all their possessions, which they had accumulated, as well as the people they had acquired in Haran. then they went out into the land of Kenaan and entered into the land of Kenaan.

#### AVRAM Y LOT PART WAYS

#### BERESHIT / GENESIS 13: 1-6, 8-12

1 Avram went up from Mitzrayim - he, his wife and all that he had, and Lot with him - to the Negev. 2 Avram became rich, with a lot of cattle, silver, and gold.

3 While he was on his travels in the Negev, he came to Beit-El, to the place where his tent had been at the beginning, between Beit-El and Ai.

4 when he had first built the altar; and there Avram called on the Name of YAHWEH.

5 Lot, who was traveling with Avram, also had flocks, herds, and tents.

6 But the land was not large enough for them to live together, because their possessions were very large and they could not live together.

8 Avram said to Lot, 'Please, let's not have quarrels between you and me, or between my shepherds and yours, since we are relatives.

9 Is not the whole earth before you? Please separate yourself from me - if you go to the left, I will go to the right; If you go to the right, I'll go to the left.'

10 Lot looked up and saw that the whole plain of the Yarden was well watered on all sides, before Yahweh destroyed Sedom and Amora, as the paradise of Yahweh, as the land of Mitzrayim in the direction of Tzoar.

11 And Lot chose all the field around the yard for himself, and Lot traveled from the east; So they separated from each other.

12 Avram lived in the land of Kenaan, and Lot lived in a city of the neighboring peoples, and pitched his tent in Sedom

#### **AVRAM FREES LOT**

#### BERESHIT / GENESIS 14: 12, 14-16

12 But as they were leaving, they took Lot, the son of Avram's brother, and his possessions; for he lived in Sedom.

14 When Avram heard that his brother Lot had been taken captive, he numbered his servants who had been born in his house, 318 of them, and went in pursuit as far as Dan.

15 During the night he and his servants divided the forces against them, then attacked and pursued them as far as Hovah, which was on the left hand of Dammesek.

16 He recovered all the goods and brought back his brother Lot with his goods, along with the women and the other people.

#### THE CIRCUMCISION, A SIGN OF THE COVENANT

#### BERESHIT / GENESIS 17: 1-7

1 When Avram was 99 years old, YAHWEH appeared to Avram and said, 'I am El Shaddai, I will make my Covenant between Me and you, and I will increase your numbers greatly.'

3 Avram fell on his face, and Elohim continued to speak to him.

4 As for me, this is my covenant with you: you will be the father of many nations.

5 Your name will no longer be Avram [exalted father], but your name will be Avraham [father of many], for I have made you the father of many nations.

6 I will cause you to be very fruitful. I will make nations of you, kings will descend from you.

7 'I am establishing my covenant between you and My Word, together with your zerah after you, generation by generation, as an everlasting covenant, to be Elohim to you and your zerah after you.





## BRIT HADASHA MORDEKHAI (MARK) 3:1 - 4:20

MORDEKHAI (MARK) 4:1-8

Again Yahshua began to teach by the lake, but the crowd that had gathered around Him was so great that He got into the boat on the lake and sat there, while the crowd stayed on land at the water's edge. He taught them many things in parables. In the course of his teachings, he said to them, 'Listen! A farmer went out to sow his seeds.

While planting, some fell on the side of the road; and the birds came and ate them; others fell into rocky spaces, where there wasn't much land. She sprouted quickly; But when the sun came up, the young plants were scorched with the scorching heat, and because their roots were not deep, they withered. Other seeds fell among thorns, and these grew and choked them; therefore, they did not produce any grain. But another seed fell on rich soil and produced grain; It sprouted and grew, and yielded a harvest of thirty, sixty, and even a hundred times what had been sown.
