**WELCOME TO PARASHA #44 OF THE TORAH:
DEVARIM WHICH MEANS: THE WORDS**

Today we begin with the study of the fifth book of the Torah, the sefer of Devarim. Moses begins his repetition of the Torah for the entire congregation of the Yisraelites, reviewing the events that occurred and the laws delivered over the course of the 40-year journey from Egypt to Sinai and the Promised Land, admonishing the people for their failings and iniquities, and enlisting them in the fulfillment of the Torah and the observance of its precepts in the land that Elohim is giving them as an eternal inheritance. which they would enter after his death.

Moses recalls the appointment of judges to ease the burden of administering justice to the people and to teach them the word of Elohim; the journey from Sinai through the vast and fearful desert; the sending of spies and the subsequent rejection of the Promised Land, so that Elohim decreed that the entire generation of the Exodus should perish in the wilderness. "Also against me," says Moses, Elohim was angry because of you, saying, "Neither will you enter there."

Moses also recalls some of the more recent events: the refusal of the nations of Moab and Ammon to allow the Yisraelite people to pass through their land; the war against the kings Emorites, Sihon and Og, the settlement on their lands by the tribes of Reuben, Gad and half the tribe of Menashe; and Moses' message to his successor, Yahoshua, who will lead the people to earth and lead them in the battles for their conquest; "Fear not them, for YHWH, your Elohim, will fight for you."

MOSES' FIRST DISCOURSE

Devarim (Deuteronomy) 1: 1-3, 6-8

- 1 These are the words that Moshe spoke to all of Yisra'el on the extreme side of the Yarden River, in the desert, in the Aravah, on the other side of Suf, between Paran and Tofel, Lavan, Hazerot and Di-Zahav.
2 It is an eleven-day journey from Horev to Kadesh-Barnea along the road of Mount Seir.
3 On the first day of the eleventh month of the fortieth year, Moshe spoke to the sons of Yisra'el, going over all that YAHWEH had commanded him to tell them.
6 YAHWEH spoke to us in Horev. He said, 'You have dwelt long enough by this mountain.
7 Turn back, move and go to the mountainous area of the Emori and all the places near the Aravah, the mountainous area, the Shefelah, the Negev and along the coast - the land of the Kenaani, and the Levanon, to the great river, the Euphrates River.
8 I have set the Earth before you! Go and take possession of the Land that YAHWEH swore to give to his parents Avraham, Yitzchak and Ya'akov, and to his zera after them.'

APPOINTMENT OF JUDGES

Devarim (Deuteronomy) 1: 9-13

- 9 'At that time I told them, 'You are a very heavy burden for me to carry alone.
10 YAHWEH his Elohim has multiplied you, so there are as many of you today as there are stars in the firmament.
11 May YAHWEH, the Elohim of your fathers, multiply you even a thousand times and bless you, as He has promised you!
12 But you are heavy, annoying, and quarrelsome! How can I bear them alone?
13 Choose for yourselves men of your tribes who are wise, knowledgeable, and knowledgeable; and I will make you chiefs over you.'

MISSION OF THE EXPLORERS

Devarim (Deuteronomy) 1: 19-24

- 19 'So we left Horev and went through all the vast and fearful wilderness which you saw on the way to the mountainous area of the Emori, as YAHWEH our Elohim commanded us; and we arrived in Kadesh-Barnea.
20 There I said to you, 'You have come to the mountainous area of the Emori, which YAHWEH our Elohim is giving us.
21 Look! YAHWEH your Elohim has set the Earth before you, take possession, as YAHWEH, the Elohim of your fathers, has told you. Do not be afraid, do not be discouraged.'
22 'You came to me, each one of you, and said, 'We are going to send men before us to explore the country for us and bring back news of what route we should use going up, and what are the cities we will meet.'
23 The idea seemed good to me, so I chose twelve men from among you, one from each tribe;
24 And they went out, went to the mountains, came to the Eshkol

DEFEAT OF THE YISRAELITES

Devarim (Deuteronomy) 1: 41-45

- 41 'Then you answered me, 'We have sinned against YAHWEH, now we will go up and fight, according to all that YAHWEH our Elohim commanded us.' And all the men among you put on their weapons, considering that it was an easy thing to climb into the mountainous area.
42 But YAHWEH said to me, 'Tell them, 'Do not go up, and do not fight, for I will not be there with you; If they do, their enemies will defeat them.'
43 Thus I had told you, but you would not listen, but instead rebelled against YAHWEH's command, took matters into your own hands, and went up to the mountainous area;
44 where the Emori who lived in that mountainous area came out against you like bees, defeated you at Seir and pursued you to Hormah.
45 You returned and wept before YAHWEH, but YAHWEH did not listen to what you said or pay any attention to you.'

TRIBES EAST OF THE YARDEN

Devarim (Deuteronomy) 3: 18-22

- 18 'At that time I gave them this command: 'YAHWEH your Elohim has given you this land to possess. But all of you who are trained to fight have to cross, armed, in front of their brothers the sons of Yisra'el.
19 Your wives, your little ones, and your cattle - I know you have a lot of cattle - will stay in your cities which I have given to you,
20 until YAHWEH allows his brethren to rest, as he has allowed you; and they also take possession of the Land which YAHWEH their Elohim is giving them on the west side of the Yarden. At that point you will return, every man to his own possession which I have given you.'
21 'Also at that time I gave this command to Yahoshua: 'Your eyes have seen all that YAHWEH your Elohim has done to these two kings. YAHWEH will do the same to all the kingdoms you encounter when you cross.
22 Do not be afraid of them, for YAHWEH your Elohim will fight for you.'



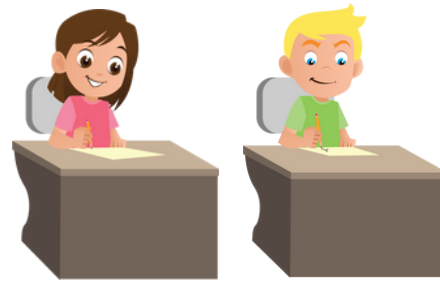
