### SUMMARY OF THE PARASHA

In this portion Moshe continues to explain to the people the different mitzvots given by the Eternal, urging them about the duty of the people and their commitment to comply with the rules of holiness demanded by the land of Yisrael. Among the topics covered in this parashá we find:

- The beautiful-looking woman, the right of the prince, the rebellious son.
- Concern about the property of others.
- Male and female outfits, scare away the mother bird from the nest, a protective fence and tzit tzit
  - The committed young woman
  - The holiness of the camp.
- Vows to the Eternal and the right of a worker to eat.
- Consideration of the orphan and the widow



### Devarim (Deuteronomy) 21:15-17 Rights of the firstborn

- 15 'If a man has two wives, one beloved and the other abhorred, and both the beloved and the abhorrent have given birth to him children, and if the firstborn is the son of the abhorred;
- 16 Then, when the time comes for him to pass on his inheritance to his children, he will not be able to give the inheritance of the firstborn to the son of the beloved wife instead of the son of the abhorred, who is in fact the firstborn.
- 17 No, he has to recognize as the firstborn the son of the hated wife for giving him a double portion of all that he possesses, because he is the first fruits of his manhood, the right of firstborn is his.

### Devarim (Deuteronomy) 21:18-21 Punishment for rebellious children

- 18 'If a man has a son who is stubborn and rebellious who does not obey what his father or mother says, and even after they discipline him, he still refuses to pay attention to them;
- 19 Then his father and his mother will grab him and take him out to the elders of his people, at the door of that place,
- 20 and they will say to the elders of their people, 'This son of ours is stubborn and rebellious, he does not pay attention to us, he lives savagely, he gets drunk.'
- 21 Then all the men of the people will stone him to death; in this way you will put an end to such perversity among you, and all Yisra'el will hear from this and be afraid.

### Devarim (Deuteronomy) 22:1-4 The property of others

- 1 'You will not see the ox or the sheep of your lost brother and you will behave as if you had not seen it; you will bring them back to your brother.
- 2 If your brother is not near; or you do not know who the owner is; you will bring him to your house; and he will remain with you until your brother asks for him, then you will return him.
- 3 You will do the same with his donkey, his attire or anything else that he loses, you will not ignore him.
- 4 'If you see your brother's donkey or ox collapsed on the road, you will not behave as if you had not seen him; you will help him get up and stand up again.

### Devarim (Deuteronomy) 22:5 Female and male feminine

- 5 'A woman cannot wear men's clothes, and a man cannot wear women's clothes; because anyone who does these things is detestable to YAHWEH your Elohim.

### Devarim (Deuteronomy) 22:12 Los tzit - tzit

- 12 You will make crooked ropes in the four corners of the outfit with which you cover yourself.

### Devarim (Deuteronomy) 23:9, 14 The holiness of the camp

- 9 'When you are in the camp, at war with your enemies, you have to guard yourself against anything bad.
- 14 Because YAHWEH your Elohim moves in your camp to rescue you and give you your enemies. Therefore, your camp will be a Kadosh place. YAHWEH should not see anything indecent among you, or He will become of you.

### Devarim (Deuteronomy) 23:21 - 25 Votes to the Eternal

- 21 'When you make a vow to YAHWEH your Elohim, you will not delay the fulfillment of it, because YAHWEH your Elohim will certainly demand it from you, and not to do so will be your sin.
- 22 If you choose not to make any kind of vows, that will not be a sin for you.
- 23 but if a vote passes your lips, you will be careful to do it according to what you voluntarily promised YAHWEH your Elohim, which you promised in loudly spoken words.
- 24 'When you enter your neighbor's vineyard, you can eat enough grapes to satisfy your appetite, but you will not put any in your basket.
- 25 When you enter the field of your neighbor where you harvest grains, you can pull out spikes with your hand; but you will not put the sickle in your neighbor's grain.
