# English Research Partnership



The English Research Partnership is a joint Leicester-shire and Rutland initiative aimed at improving English outcomes at both Primary and Secondary age groups. Natalie Teece from John Ferneley College ran 2 ERP launch events

in July that were very well-attended. The aim of the launch was to make people aware of how the ERP wish to create an English focused research group. 71 people attended over the 2 days, which is great. This included many primary colleagues but also 19 secondary schools, there were lots of English leads, but also classroom teachers and some who had been involved in SSIF projects. Key areas were identified, but there was a majority interest in the themes of: Reading and promoting Reading for Pleasure, Real-Life writing experiences and Oracy.

Other areas of work for the ERP are making links with The Literacy trust, mapping English provision across the 3 counties, developing a website and a Spring conference. The next ERP Teacher meet is on Wednesday 23rd October and is to be held at Wreake Valley Academy, Parkstone Rd, Syston, Leicester LE7 1LY at 3.45pm for a 4pm start.
