# What are the statutory requirements of the Appropriate Body (AB)?



#### Induction for newly qualified teachers (England)

Statutory guidance for appropriate bodies, headteachers, school staff and governing bodies

Revised December 2016





#### Key points

- All qualified teachers who are employed in a relevant school in England must, by law, have completed an induction period satisfactorily, subject to specified exemptions (see Annex B).
- Statutory induction is not a legal requirement to teach in FE or the independent sector, academies, free schools and BSOs, but may be served in these settings.
- An appropriate body has the main quality assurance role within the induction process.





#### As an AB what will TELA do?

- Make 1 visit to the school to quality assure your processes for the induction of the NQT.
- Ensure Monitoring, support and assessment during induction
- A suitable monitoring and support programme must be put in place for the NQT, personalised to meet their professional development needs (including the development needs of part-time NQTs). This must include:
- Support and guidance from a designated induction tutor who holds
  QTS and has the time and experience to carry out the role effectively
- Observation of the NQT's teaching and follow-up discussion
  Regular professional reviews of progress
- NQT's observation of experienced teachers either in the NQT's own institution or in another institution where effective practice has been identified





# As a School / Mentor you should

- Ensure an appointment of an induction tutor
- Ensure regular observation of the NQT's teaching practice
- Ensure professional progress reviews of the NQT
- Gather formal assessments
- React to any concerns raised
