With new improvements at Becker Park, the event will look different than in past years. The traditional softball tournament and related food, beer and vendor offerings will be held at Welcome Park; while stage entertainment, bounce houses, vendor fair, food trucks and Omni Brewing will be at Becker Park. The carnival from past years at Becker Park will be replaced with large bounce houses; and the fireworks at Becker Park will be replaced with an LED light show on the stage Saturday night. Fireworks will be held at Welcome Park on Friday night.

- All vendors selling items must submit a copy of their ST19 form with this application
- Craft/Art items for sale must be homemade and pre-approved by Crystal Frolics.
- Vendor must be open during stated time periods, but may stay longer if desired.
- The event is outdoors and will be held rain or shine – fees are not refundable due to weather.
