Spring Rabies Clinic Announced

The Humane Society of Wyoming County reminds all dog and cat guardians that rabies vaccinations are **mandatory** in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

In order to assist county residents in obtaining these required vaccinations for their dogs and household cats over three months of age, the HSWC is sponsoring a low-cost rabies vaccination clinic on **Saturday**, **May 4**, **2019**, from 9 a.m. to 12 noon at the PA Department of Agriculture Building, Route 92 South, Tunkhannock (next to Bartron's John Deere tractor store). Dr. Abbey Jones of the Schultzville Animal Hospital will be administering the vaccinations, at a very reasonable cost of \$8 per shot (cash only, please).

Owners are required to have their companion animals either leashed or in an individual carrier, and under control at all times. Please bring the animal's most recent rabies vaccination certificate if one is available. **Residents from any county are welcome to attend this event.**



Remember: vaccinating pets protects not only the animal population, but the human population as well.

Cruelty Investigations in Wyoming County

Our Humane Society Police Officer, Darrell Sands, continues to investigate a sad number of calls on animal abuse, neglect, and cruelty in our county. Officer Sands has successfully prosecuted eight cases in magisterial court during the last few months. During the winter, a large number of calls were responded to involving the illegal tethering of dogs in sub-freezing weather, as well as other animals with improper shelter and inadequate food or water. Several cases of animal hoarding were investigated, with animals (and sometimes people) living in deplorable conditions. Other calls included abandoned dogs, neglect of farm animals, requests for animal welfare checks, injured or abandoned cats, and dogs injured on the side of the road. In many cases, owners are educated on proper animal care and current animal welfare laws, and the problem can be corrected without filing charges. Other animal guardians, however, refuse to cooperate and can then face charges.

- Contact us (or local police) if you witness animal abuse. Calls are confidential.
- Make sure your pet is always wearing an I.D. tag. (We receive many calls on found pets, and would be able to return them home quickly if only they had on proper ID!)
- Prepare a disaster plan that includes your pet.
- Be sure all your pets are spayed or neutered to fight pet overpopulation.
- Think about adopting a pet from a shelter or rescue rather than purchasing one.
- If you shop on Amazon, indicate our name under the "Amazon Smile" program, and we receive a donation for each purchase made.
- Sign up your Shur-Save Gold Card for our organization, and we earn a rebate on your purchases.
- Consider a bequest to the HSWC in your will.

<u>Important Reminder</u>

2019 dog licenses were due by law on January 1st. If you haven't yet purchased your dog license, please do so immediately. This will help you avoid a fine and provide identification should your dog become lost. Wyoming County dog licenses are available at the courthouse, as well as designated area businesses. All dogs 3 months and older must be licensed each year. Discounts are available for spayed or neutered pets, and for senior or disabled owners.

For ease of purchase, dog licenses will be on sale during our May 4th rabies clinic.

FINANCIAL FACTS

Again in 2018. our organization's expenses ceded our income. Our biggest costs include fielding a humane police officer, our spay and neuter program, veterinary services, and insurance. For several years now, we have had to dip into savings. Why did we do this? Because we will not allow animal cruelty to go without investigation in our county, or for pets to multiply because their owners cannot afford spay or neuter surgeries.

Please note that we are extremely careful with our funds. All checks must be signed by two individuals, a financial report is given each month at our Board meetings, we file all appropriate tax documents with the IRS, and we are planning an official audit in the very near future. Our treasurer is bonded. Donations, of course, are always needed and appreciated to keep us going!

Spay and Neuter Program

The Humane Society of Wyoming County's low-cost spay and neuter program continues to help income-eligible county residents afford these surgeries for their companion animals.


