2025-2026 Terms & Conditions

- I understand that my role as a "Suzuki Parent" requires that I attend all lessons to observe and take notes so that the home practice can be most effective. At a later time* students may be able to come to lessons alone, but this will be decided in discussion with the teacher. *this later time generally occurs sometime in the Middle School or High School years
- Ensure your student is prepared for each lesson by bringing: assignment book (for parent or student to record weekly practice assignments), method book, note reading, flashcards, other music (etudes, solos, orchestra, audition material).
- A parent must accompany a student to group class until the age of 11. Some group activities include parental involvement and follow-through in home practice. Also, this is a safety precaution since we are guests of our group lesson location.
- Tuition is paid over 9 months and covers 32 lessons, 22 group lessons, and recital fees. There will be a \$20 fee per student per recital for pianist fees. This fee will be added onto the recital month's tuition. Summer lessons will be scheduled and offered as fits both the student's and teacher's summer schedule. A minimum of 4 summer lessons is required of each student to keep their place in their studios for the following Fall semester. The 9 months are September, October, November, December, January, February, March, April, and May.
- Cancellation Policy: Parents are required to give 30 days notice before discontinuing lessons. Retaining Lesson Time: Since schedules are filled in the fall, it is expected that all students will take lessons for the entire school year. Withdrawal from the program will be considered permanent unless there are very unusual circumstances such as severe, extended illness. The scheduled lesson time cannot be held open for more than a month. Payment must be completed for the entire semester before the discontinuation of lessons. For example, if a student quits in October, payment for November and December is still required. If a student quits in January, payment for February, March, April, and May is still required. Taking private Suzuki lessons is a commitment and Primavera Place teachers are dedicated, career teachers. Everyone's time is valuable and should be treated with utmost respect and care. Since teachers are not able to fill lesson slots mid-semester, they still need their income from their committed studios.
- Make-ups: There is a strict 24-hour cancellation policy. Lessons cannot be made-up if it is cancelled by the student or parent less than 24 hours in advance. The teacher will have to make-up the lesson if the teacher cancels the lesson less than 24 hours in advance. Each teacher makes their own individual private teaching lesson schedule (for example, starting in August vs. September, which holidays they choose not to teach, etc.) but each will have 32 lesson slots during the academic year and 4 during the summer. If a lesson can be rescheduled at a time that works for both the student and the teacher, this option will be considered if done so with more than 24 hours notice. PLEASE do not take advantage of this policy. If you can work out a swap with another student, this is fine, but any swaps should work well for both parties. Additionally, Skype/ Zoom lessons are available when the student or teacher is ill, but "well enough" to take a lesson from home, or when other circumstances prevent the student or teacher from getting to the studio for a lesson. There is an additional option where the teacher may request the student to record their working pieces and the teacher can then submit comments to improve practice until the next lesson. This is an option at the discretion and availability of the studio teacher. Remember, you pay for the time in your teacher's schedule. In other words, you have to pay for the couch whether you sit in it or not!
- Sickness: In the event that a student or parent is sick and knows less than 24 hours before a scheduled lesson: Option 1: Sick party must wear a mask and attend an in-person lesson. Option 2: The lesson should be held virtually using the platform of the teacher's choice. Option 3: The student/parent may opt to use one of their two (2) sickness make-up lesson passes. Teachers reserve the right to not teach a student who is showing visible signs of sickness. By signing this agreement you are agreeing that you are aware of your private teacher's make-up and sickness policy.
- Payment is due by the 1st of every month. If payment has not been received by the 1st, a late fee of \$12 will be added. You can pay via check, cash, or Zelle.
- I understand my \$55 Registration Fee for the 2025-2026 Studio year is due August 20th, 2025. I understand that my students' first month's tuition is due by September 1st, 2025.
