



Instructions For Eating, Shipping Peanuts:

How Do I Eat Boiled Peanuts? Boiled Peanuts can be eaten cold or hot. It's more so a preference; however, if it were me, I prefer Hot over cold. Most people crack the shell, eat the nut inside and toss away the peanut shell; however, the shell is edible and can be eaten.

The Peanuts came frozen or packaged in a vacuum seal bag. How should I warm them up properly? If the peanuts came frozen, I suggest you let them thaw out first. Once the thawing out process has

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completed, open the vacuum seal bag and pour the peanuts and content into a sauce-pan. Add some water to the sauce-pan. Just enough to get the water boiling. Once the water starts boiling, let the peanuts boil for 3 to 4 minutes.

*****Note***** (The Peanuts are already fully cooked and ready when they arrive to you. At this point the goal is to get them hot again)

What if I receive my peanuts and the vacuum packaging looks like it has either been tampered with or not air tight? What should I do? First thing you should do, is reach out to us and inform us about this. There is a possibility that the peanuts are perfectly fine and that they were in a heated area during shipment. The best way to know, is by doing a smell test. When you smell the peanuts they should have a pleasant smell to them. If the peanuts do not have a pleasant smell to them, more than likely they have spoiled during shipment. Please notify us and we will work on reshipping your order. Please throw out the peanuts and do not attempt to eat them if they have a sour smell to them.

What if I don't eat all the peanuts right away or if I received the peanuts and I want to eat them later? How can I preserve my peanuts? Once you receive your order, it is best to place them in the fridge or freezer. If you don't plan on eating the peanuts for over 3 weeks, I would place the packaging in the freezer. They can last close to over a year while in the freezer. If you plan to eat them in the next 3 weeks or less, I would place them in the fridge.

Please keep in mind that when in transit, the peanuts could be sitting on the back of a truck, which means when they get to you, the best thing to do is give it some type of refrigeration. If you eat some and want to store the rest for later, store the unused content in a zip lock bag and place them in the freezer until you are ready to use unused content again.

*****Note*****

Boiled Peanuts are a perishable food item. If not given proper refrigeration within a decent time, they can spoil. The best way to know that they are spoil is by doing a smell test. You will not have to second guess it. If they are spoiled they will give you that same feeling like spoiled milk. We try our hardest to provide as much information as possible to prevent this from happening and customers normally do not run into this issue with the information provided.

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
