GROUNDS / BUILDINGS

- Fall is underway and soon we will conduct Fall Clean Up, Fall Shrub Trim along with Gutter cleaning. Fall clean up means we will be working on grounds, all shrubs will be trimmed along with Holly Trees, and gutters will be cleaned out. Will have three leaf removals over coming months.
- Fall means we will be replacing shrubs identified by Brammer landscaping, planting a new tree at 10505 where a tree was removed.
- Tree thinning and pruning will be taking place sometime in October plus removing a dead pine in the back will take place.
- Gutter downspouts have been taken care of based on our Roofer and gutter team.
- Prepare for freezing weather by turning off your outside water. This means garage and patio faucets when temp becomes freezing. Winter begins December 21. Daylight savings ends November 7
