#### **BOARD BUZZ**

The new 2022 Board of Directors hit the ground running when we met for the first time in January. Once again this year we intend to keep you in the know with what we are working on. This past meeting, we decided to table indefinitely the installation of speed bumps as it appears that most of the community were not in favor as a solution to slowing down the boulevard traffic. There is always a lot of things going on with Grounds and Buildings as that is a never ending process and Ed will keep everyone posted on progress of different projects in another portion of this newsletter as usual.

The board did vote on changes to 2 rules and regulations this past month. One is that there will no longer be a \$50 fee charged for the rental of the clubhouse however nothing else has changed in that rental agreement and \$100 refundable deposit must still be submitted in order to reserve. Also changed was the weight limitation for dogs being increased from 35 lbs. to 50 lbs. Please note that nothing else has been changed in this regulation in regards to breeds that are not acceptable. We as a board look forward to working to insure we continue to be the best community to live in in this area! Remember to look out for your neighbors!

#### **GROUNDS / BUILDINGS**

- Building SR's due to weather conditions are on hold for now. Once weather warms up our vendors will address those requests.
- WHGH is prepared for snow removal if the snow fall needs attention for removal.
- Service Requests please complete in detail including your email if you are looking for a reply.
- Insurance documentation, inform your agent to send WHGH a copy when policy renews, or you provide the office a copy. Refer to R & R article 5 for additional insurance information.
- Grounds will be taking plant inventory for 2022. This will cover necessary shrub removal, shrub planting, and other grounds maintenance. We are working to improve our drainage needs.
- Note that all repairs, changes or upgrades that are visible from the outside must first be approved in writing by the Board of Directors.
- Preparation for selling your unit, refer to Article 4 Owner responsibility. Very important for preparing to sell a unit.
