• As stated before, landscaping meaning shrubs/bushes and trees will be addressed come fall. Why Fall? We do not have irrigation meaning there is no way to water new plantings. During the year, inventory will be taken on shrubs to remove and shrubs to plant. There is no need to prepare a SR for shrubs as this will be handled as just outlined. In addition, this fall our plan is to seed areas that are bare to grow grass. Ed Heymann blew the window of opportunity for planting grass seed in 2021.

Downspouts and gutters now that weather is cooperating will be looked after

- I expect mortar repair to begin soon now that weather is cooperating. If you see someone around your home that will be Jack Hurd our stone mason. In addition, our painter John Weiland will be taking care of the lintels, and B & J Roofing working on downspouts.

- Smoke alarms need to be inspected with daylight saving time coming in two weeks March 13th. Turn clocks forward, spring forward as they say.

FROM OUR BOARD SECRETARY....

One thing I believe needs to be communicated is the need for residents to present person(s) for serving on the Board of Directors. At this time, I am not sure how many persons need to be elected, but it should be either two (2) or three (3). Elections will be in November.

My own experience is that persons rarely volunteer to run for election for such offices, but most often when they are recommended by their friends or neighbors. As such, I would recommend that we begin asking for residents to nominate persons they believe would be good B.O.D. members and then encourage them to agree to be nominated. (I have found that the encouragement of friends to pursue me to do something, that I am more likely to do so rather than to decide myself to pursue it.)

Info: Insurance Certificates: The Rules of WHGH requires each resident to provide a copy of their Insurance Certificate to WHGH each year when renewal takes place. (This is often overlooked or simply forgotten.)

Please be advised that most Insurance Companies allow you to add WHGH onto their mailing list for these Certificates at the time of each renewal. This would (1) assure WHGH getting the Certificate and (2) remove the responsibility of each resident "remembering" to do this each year. (This took me about 2 minutes to accomplish with Nationwide Mutual Insurance)

Info: Payment of Maintenance Fees: There are three (3) manners in which these fees may be paid each month.

- 1. Drop off your payment into the large box in front of the Club House.

- 3. Arrange for your Bank or Credit Union to mail your payment each month to the noted address. (Most Banks and Credit Unions do this for no cost to the account holder.)

Note: WHGH <u>does 'NOT"</u> have the ability to make automatic withdrawals from your account(s) nor for you nor your Bank to make electronic transfers into the WHGH account.
