
CLOSING TIPS

Seasonals, here are a few tips for closing your campsite for the season.

- **Unplug any outdoor lights**
- **Unplug your camper or turn the power off to your cabin**
- **Turn off your water spicket and unhook the garden hose from both the camper/cabin and drain the hose, connect the hose together and store it away for winter.**
- **If you have an on demand water heater, take it down, home and store it in a warm place for the winter, this prevents freezing and damage.**
- **Add fuel stabilizer to your golf cart, run the gas as low as possible.**
- **Unhook the battery terminals on your golf cart and camper.**
- **Dryer sheets, moth balls or peppermint soaked cotton balls in cups throughout your camper or cabin can help to keep rodents away.**
- **Some cover their campers and some don't, that is your choice.**
- **Turn your propane tanks off for the winter.**
- **Lastly if you have a camper, make sure it is wintered so your pipes don't freeze over winter. Call the office for more info and pricing on who can help with that.**
