Abuse, fairness and anonymity:

Survey abuse – As with any website your computer/smartphone/tablet connects to, it displays your public IP Address. [Devices connecting from the same modem/router will have the same public IP Address]

To help protect privacy we turn your IP address into a randomly assigned 'barcode' which allows us to mitigate abuse while retaining anonymity.

Anonymity – To help ensure anonymity we have not collected any personal information that could identify individuals.


Fairness – To ensure a wide and varied reach, we have advertised the survey on multiple platforms such as Local TV, Radio, Local Press and Social Media.













Do you have a criminal record in Guernsey?






Have you ever been arrested and charged in Guernsey for drug possession?




Have you ever used illegally obtained pharmaceutical drugs in Guernsey?




Are you currently addicted to pharmaceutical drugs?




Have you ever been addicted to pharmaceutical drugs?












