- Optional: colored pencils or chalk pencils for additional shading

- black Zendala or smooth and heavy black card stock cut into 4.5" circle
- new gold Gelly Roll - I like to have a backup or two in case one gives me grief
- colored pencils such as Faber Castell Polychromos or Prismacolor Premiere (your favourite colours. I'll likely be using greens; blues; pink or purples. But you can really use whatever you like
- colorless blender - I like the Prismacolor colorless blender.
- paper towel to wipe off your Gelly Roll

- white Zendala or hot press watercolor paper cut into 4.5" circle
- your favourite black pen - I like Micron PN
