

Nursing Scholarship Application Guide

Application instructions and requirements

This guide provides a comprehensive overview of the application process for the Nursing Scholarship. We value personal commitment, academic achievement, and honoring the legacy of nurses who have dedicated their lives to caring for others. Please read the following instructions carefully.

Application Requirements

To be considered for the Nursing Scholarship, applicants must submit the following materials:

- **Letter of Acceptance:** A formal letter of acceptance from an accredited nursing program is required. This letter confirms your enrollment and commitment to pursuing a nursing degree.
- **Personality Video:** Create a 3-5 minute video explaining your reasons for choosing nursing and why you deserve the scholarship. This is your opportunity to express your passion, share your story, and demonstrate your unique qualities.
- **Recommendation Letters:** Submit three letters of recommendation from teachers, healthcare professionals, or community leaders. These letters should attest to your character, dedication, and potential as a nurse.
- **Transcripts:** Provide your most recent academic transcripts, including your cumulative GPA. This demonstrates your academic achievements and commitment to excellence.

Application Details

Letter of Acceptance

Ensure the letter is an official document from the nursing program. It should clearly state your acceptance into the program and the start date. Unofficial letters or screenshots may not be accepted.

Personality Video

Focus on expressing your true self. Share personal experiences, motivations, and aspirations. Be creative and authentic! Technical quality is less important than content. Ensure the video is within the 3-5 minute limit.

Recommendation Letters

Choose recommenders who know you well and can speak to your character, work ethic, and potential as a nurse. Provide them with ample time and information to write a strong letter of support. Follow up with your references to make sure they submit their letter before the deadline.

Transcripts

Request official transcripts from your academic institution(s). Ensure that the transcripts are complete and up-to-date. Unofficial transcripts may be accepted initially, but official transcripts will be required if you are selected as a finalist.

Submission Deadline

All application materials must be submitted by June 5, 2026. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

1. Gather all required documents.
2. Record your personality video.
3. Request letters of recommendation.
