

Criteria for the scholarship application:

1. **Letter of Acceptance**: Applicants must provide a formal letter of acceptance into an accredited nursing program. This verifies their commitment to pursuing a career in nursing.

2. **Personality Video**: Instead of a written essay, applicants should submit a short video (3-5 minutes) explaining why they have chosen nursing as their career path and why they believe they are deserving of the scholarship. This format honors the memory of the nurse by emphasizing personal expression and storytelling.

3. **Recommendation Letters**: Three letters of recommendation are required. These should come from individuals who can attest to the applicant's character, dedication, and potential in the field of nursing. Ideal sources include teachers, healthcare professionals, or community leaders.

4. **Transcripts**: Applicants must submit their most recent academic transcripts, highlighting their cumulative GPA to ensure they meet academic standards.

Deadline: All application materials must be submitted by June 5, 2026.

This approach ensures that the scholarship application process values personal commitment and academic achievement, while also honoring the nurse's legacy in a meaningful way.
