At Dean Andreozzi – Fruitport, Michigan, USA, accessible from guitardean.com, one of our main priorities is the privacy of our visitors. This Privacy Policy document contains types of information that is collected and recorded by guitardean.com and how we use it.

General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

We are a Data Controller of your information.

Guitardean.com legal basis for collecting and using the personal information described in this Privacy Policy depends on the Personal Information we collect and the specific context in which we collect the information:

- guitardean.com needs to perform a contract with you
- You have given guitardean.com permission to do so
- Processing your personal information is in guitardean.com legitimate interests
- guitardean.com needs to comply with the law

Guitardean.com will retain your personal information only for as long as is necessary for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy. We will retain and use your information to the extent necessary to comply with our legal obligations, resolve disputes, and enforce our policies.

If you are a resident of the European Economic Area (EEA), you have certain data protection rights. If you wish to be informed what Personal Information we hold about you and if you want it to be removed from our systems, please contact us.

Log Files

Guitardean.com follows a standard procedure of using log files. These files log visitors when they visit websites. All hosting companies do this and a part of hosting services' analytics. The information collected by log files include internet protocol (IP) addresses, browser type, Internet Service Provider (ISP), date and time stamp, referring/exit pages, and possibly the number of clicks. These are not linked to any information that is personally identifiable. Cookies and Web Beacons
