## CONTEST RULES

- Contestants will play two numbers, a waltz, and a hoe down or tune of their choice. (Examples: hornpipe, polka, rag, jig, etc.) Fast tunes should be danceable tunes. Contestants should come prepared with a play-off tune.
- 2. Trick or fancy fiddling will disqualify a contestant. Included are: holding the fiddle in an abnormal position, plucking the strings other than normally, over-embellishment of a piece. "Orange Blossom Special", "Black Mountain Rag," are not acceptable tunes. No medleys allowed and no cross-tuning. If a tune is played that isn't appropriate for the category or in line with the rules, it will result in 0 points.
- 3. Contact microphones and amplified instruments are NOT allowed.
- 4. Contestant will draw for order of appearance prior to start of contest. Contestants must be ready when called.
- 5. Each fiddler will be limited to no more than two accompaniments. Allowable accompaniments are: key board, guitar, mandolin, and bass fiddle. (Parent's signature if participant is under 18 years of age).
- 6. Tunes must be played from memory. No music is allowed on stage for the fiddler.
