Minutes from The Recycling Committee (draft)

Meeting called to order at 4:00 pm.

Harry made a motion to accept the minutes for November 11th and November 25. Barbara seconded the motion.

RC volunteers have offered to sell Westmoreland trash bags at the Transfer Station located on London Cross Road. This will be a temporary solution until a more permanent solution is found. There are three contracted stores currently selling bags. Barn and Thistle, J&J,s and Market Basket. They report that business is good and there are no problems ordering bags. We will try to enlist another store or two in Westmoreland.

Harry made a motion for someone to post information on the Westmoreland Facebook site with no comments but have a link to the town's website. On the town's website there will be facts about the Recycle Center. Residents can look at the site and get accurate information. Hailey seconded the motion.

Victor will look into ordering 7 more sandwich boards from NH recycles. They will be placed by each container to indicate whether the load goes to the landfill or sent off to be recycled. Also included will be the size and cost of each container. Let's also get some kind of covers for the containers that are open to the weather.

Those of us who are good with facts and figures are compiling data to show the savings the RC has accrued. Comparing last year to this year there is a significant amount of savings.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:30pm.
