Call to Order 6:20

Chris Lynch of Matrix Design Group spoke to the committee about what his company can provide to communities. They have built networks for ten New England towns, including similar-sized towns in Vermont, including Bethel. Also Leverett, Mass., Petersham, Mass., and current proposal to Penobscot, NH, Alford, Mass.

The committee heard about the following offerings: Offer of 20 year network, 3 municipal accounts for free, discount for disadvantaged students, grant a local designee read-only access to network vital stats. Standard service would cost \$95 for 50 Mbps symmetrical.
